Fun Obstacle Competition

Dogs will jump according to height, and there will be a trophy and a prize for the 1st Place in each of three height categories: -

Standard Fun Obstacle

Members may run the course as many times as they like at £1 per go

Rally,O

Rally,O is off lead obedience heelwork, following station boards around a course and acting on the instructions on the boards.

There will be a trophy and prize for the winner in each of two categories: -

Best Beginners Obedience – for those handlers whose dogs have never attended Gold Plus classes where Rally,O is taught.

Best Improvers Obedience – for handlers whose dogs have attended Gold Plus classes.

Members can have as many attempts at the course as they wish at £1 per attempt.
