The National Animal Welfare Trust has come up with a new way of using your defunct tax disc holder – storing emergency information about you and your pets.

The forms can be printed out at home if you have access to a printer, filled in and then neatly folded up to be kept in your windscreen.

How to use this form

Fill in contact details of your next of kin plus how to contact the nominated carer(s) for your pet(s). **Be safe** - a first name and phone number will do.

Use the blank circles on the other sides of the page to include more information about your pets eg. vet information, medical ailments etc. Add in any useful information for your rescuers such as 'Fido is nervous of strangers'.

Print this sheet out on an A4 piece of paper, cut out the circle string, fold and then place in your tax disc holder.
